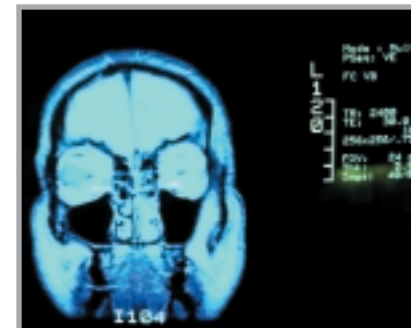
- Year 'round anti insurance fraud training seminars, free to employees of member companies, and held all throughout New York State.

ny ACT- In the news, on the airwaves, and reaching out to fight insurance fraud

Over the years, NYACT has been the subject of several "Anti-Car Theft" news features on Channels 4, 5 and 7. NYACT delivered its message during primetime television: total commitment to preventing auto theft and halting the criminal element that has turned auto theft and insurance fraud (especially in the PIP area) into a sophisticated, money-making bonanza at the expense of consumers and insurers. Although auto theft in New York State has been reduced by more 38% over the last 10 years, other auto related crime has more than doubled. NYACT needs to continue its fast pace to keep insurance personnel and law enforcement prepared and trained in the fight against insurance fraud crimes, such as staged accidents, "jump ins" at an accident site, runners, stolen identity, caused accidents, forged accident reports and medical mill claims. These crimes, with all of their subsequent medical and property claim costs, have had a negative impact on the insurance rates for all insureds.

NYACT's message and acclaimed training programs have had a real and positive effect on fighting fraud in New York State.
