NYACT in conjunction with the National Insurance Crime Bureau, the New York City Police Department, the New York State Department of Motor Vehicles and the New York State Police will co-sponsor a 4-Day Advanced Auto Theft School, set for Tuesday, June 16th, 8:00 am through Friday, June 19th, 4:15 pm (REGISTRATION is set for Tuesday, 7:00 am to 8:00 am). This course is being offered to law enforcement personnel only and will be free of charge. Lunch will be provided complimentary as well for all attendees.
