Insurers' Statutory & Regulatory Obligations To Provide File Materials & Information

David O. Brink, Esq., Smith & Brink, P.C., Quincy, MA. Mr. Brink is a trial attorney for the law firm of Smith & Brink, P.C., which provides legal counsel on class action, coverage and unfair claims-practice issues associated with fraudulent claims and complex property-insurance losses. Mr. Brink's trial practice in the state and federal courts encompasses a broad range of insurance law cases, including federal RICO litigation, arson for profit, fraudulent property losses and staged bodily injury claims. Mr. Brink is the attorney of record on numerous appellate decisions and is the author of many articles on insurance and SIU matters. Remington ELSAG License Plate Reader An Overview & Update

Charles Bardong, Vice President, Elsag North America. Mr. Bardong serves as the federal, state and local law enforcement liaison and operations coordinator for Elsag North America having joined Elsag in 2008. Prior to Elsag, Mr. Bardong served as Director of the New York State Insurance Frauds Bureau, appointed by former Superintendent of Insurance Gregory V. Serio on January 16, 2003. In this role, Mr. Bardong oversaw statewide insurance fraud investigations conducted by the Bureau's 60 investigators in offices in Manhattan, Brooklyn, Mineola, Albany, Buffalo, Syracuse, Rochester and Oneonta. Under his leadership, the Frauds Bureau posted record-breaking statistics. Prior to the NYS IFB, Mr. Bardong served as Chief Investigator for the Moreland Act Commission on New York City Schools. Prior to this, he served as Deputy Chief of the New York State Inspector General's Office and spent 22 years with the New York City Police Department where he rose to the rank of Lieutenant. Mr. Bardong will provide an overview and update on the success of Remington Elsag's License Plate Reader (LPR).
